Parade services:

Those on duty may be asked to attend a rehearsal. Therefore it is important that you contact Fr Tony ***not later than the beginning of the previous month***. For example if you are on duty on March 11, by the beginning of February you should have discussed it with Fr Tony. If you miss this, he may assign your slots to someone else when preparing his ministry rota.

What if your date is unsuitable?

Please swap with another group. Once you have arranged your swap, please amend the rota accordingly in the red folder at the back of the church and inform Agnes in the Benefice Office.

How to find out what your lessons are?

Check the online calendar: <https://sites.google.com/site/allhallowsandsaints>

Click on the grey header of any Sunday (for example Advent 1), and a pop-up window will appear with additional information.

Also, a list will be sent to you by email shortly from Adeola Amisu who is in charge of the reading rota.

Children's groups only: you can use a child-friendly version of your lessons, but please talk to Fr Tony first, at least a month in advance, then send the full text in electronic format to the Benefice Office so that it can be printed on the folios.

Other groups: please look up the lessons yourself in the NRSV (New Revised Standard Version) edition of the Bible.

How to choose your own hymns?

Any group on duty may suggest hymns for their service to Fr Tony and Harrison Cook, who will then decide whether these are appropriate. If you intend to do so, please ask them at least **a month before** your date.

How many people are needed?

- ⤴ Bring the bread and the wine to the altar: 2.
- ⤴ Help with the collection: at least 2.
- ⤴ Read the lessons: at least 2 (one for each lesson), though you may experiment with more than one voice. Much of the Bible uses the device of 'reported speech' and so lends itself to dramatic presentation.
- ⤴ Intercessions: at least 1, but again, don't be afraid to experiment. Prayer can involve more than one intercessor, singing, candles, bells and more.
- ⤴ Parade services only: it depends on what you discuss with Fr Tony.
