Suncatchers

- Tissue paper of different colours.
- Tracing paper or baking paper.
- Ribbon or string

Cut out an egg shape from your chosen paper.

Cut the middle out to create a frame.

Stick ribbon or string onto the edge at the top and leave hanging down the middle.

Stick strips of tissue paper across the egg shape.

Stick strip on the other side if you want to once the first side is dry.

Leave to dry. Once dry trim any tissue paper off around the edge.

Hang up in your window or make several to go on an Easter tree.

Make an Easter card from materials you can find around the house.

Post it through your friends' door along the street or to a relative.
